

The following tables list dates from the past three years (2018-2020) that had flood threat [Messages](#) issued by MHFD's long-running [F2P2](#) (Flash Flood Prediction Program), which has been serving the Denver/Boulder metro area since 1979. The contrast between 2019 and 2020 is particularly interesting with 2019 having nearly twice as many threat days as this past year.

LEGEND:

- **Red** indicates rain alarms affecting MHFD
- **Blue** indicates rain alarms impacting locations outside MHFD service area (Examples: *Saint Vrain watershed in northern Boulder County & Hayman Burn Area in southwest Douglas County*)
- * NWS flash flood watch (*none in 2019 & 2020*)
- ** NWS flash flood warning
